Parking for Heller:

After you enter the campus, take the loop road to your right and follow signs toward "Upper Campus." The Heller School is at the top of the hill on the loop road on your left. Park in the Tower Parking Lot directly across the street from the Heller School Building (or in the small parking areas just before and just past the Heller School).

The Zinner Forum

The Heller School consists of two buildings: Heller Brown on your left as you face the buildings and the new Irving Schneider Family building on your right. The Zinner Forum is located in the Heller School's Schneider Building. It is the large atrium that you enter from outside and you will need to proceed down the stairs. (An elevator is available just inside the main doors of the Schneider building to the left.) The Zinner Forum is on the "G" or Ground level.) Signs will be posted for the event.

Directions by car or public transportation:

From the Mass. Turnpike (I-90) Eastbound

Take exit 14 for I-95/Rt 128. After the toll, keep left for 95/128 North. While on ramp, exit immediately onto exit 24 for Route 30. Bear left onto Route 30. Turn right at first traffic light onto River Road. This becomes South Street and Brandeis is two miles ahead on the left.

From the Mass. Turnpike (I-90) Westbound

Take exit 15 for I-95/Rt 128 and Route 30. After the toll proceed straight for Route 30. Turn right at end of the ramp, and then right again at first traffic light onto Route 30. Turn left at next traffic light onto River Road. This becomes South Street and Brandeis is two miles ahead on the left.

From I-95/Route 128 Northbound

Take exit 24 for Route 30. Route 30 is one of several options at this exit, so follow signs carefully. Turn left at the top of the ramp onto Route 30. Turn right at the traffic lights. This is River Road which becomes South Street, and Brandeis is two miles ahead on the left.

By commuter rail

Commuter train service is available from Boston's North Station (Fitchburg / South Acton line) to the Brandeis/Roberts Station that borders the campus.
